



Lark Hill Rise Animal Policy

Bright futures nursery school take's full responsibility for any animals kept in the area Lark Hill Rise forest school. This requires more than simply protecting them from cruelty. We need to meet their needs for food, water and living space, protect them from disease, and create a healthy and stress-free living environment for them.

Any animals living on the premises will be checked on a daily basis to ensure they have adequate living space, food and water.

If an animal becomes unwell or show signs of disease, bright futures will take full responsibility and will take the animal in question to a Veterinary clinic for treatment.

As part of this policy all children will need parental permission to handle animals to ensure that they have no allergies and also notify parents of the possibility that their child could possibly receive animal bites or scratches.
