



Lark Hill Rise Forest school Tree Climbing Risk Assessment

An adult must be present when wanting to climb trees in the Forest School. The ground cover should be checked for 'sharp objects' and the tree marked as suitable for climbing. A visual check must be made for loose and rotten branches. Children are permitted to explore to their own limits or to a maximum height of 1.5m. Adults should be near enough to catch if a child should fall but far enough away to not be invasive to the children's exploration. Children are not permitted to tree climb without asking an adult first (See forest school risk assessment).
